The Literacy Council Adds Saffire Grill Tickets to Line-Up of Raffles

Specialty grill and three vehicles will be raffled at 100 Men Who Cook Event on May 22

The Saffire Grill, courtesy of Benson Stone Co., is described as “3 cookers in one,” and can be used as a smoker and wood-fired pizza oven. The ceramic grill offers a sealed design that requires very little air flow to stay hot, which prevents the food from drying out or shrinking.
